39<sup>th</sup> Annual Essay Contest: High School: grades 9-12

### Deadline: February 16, 2024

### Purpose:

To encourage, to recognize, and to reward Tennessee high school students who demonstrate outstanding writing skills.

### **Eligibility:**

All Tennessee high school students, public and private, in grades 9 –12 are eligible.

### **Guidelines for Submitting Essays:**

- Each student may submit only one essay.
- Each essay must address the topic below and meet the formatting requirements on page 2.
- Essays and cover sheets (see page 4) should be emailed to Dr. Dorrie Powell (<u>Powell.dorrie@gmail.com</u>) no later than midnight on Friday, February 16, 2024.
- Members of Beta Sigma Chapter will select the top entries from each school to be forwarded to the state contest and award prize money to the top three entries from all submissions.

### Topic:

Write an essay that expresses your opinion on the following question:

### Artificial intelligence [A.I.] is beginning to have a tremendous impact on our world. In what ways will A.I. positively and negatively affect your daily life, now and in the future?

Be sure to:

- Address the question,
- Include your own personal experiences, but you are not limited to first-hand knowledge.
- Use an organizing structure appropriate to the purpose, audience, and content.

### Format:

- Students will include both advantages and disadvantages of artificial intelligence [A.I.].
- They will effectively utilize argumentation strategies to develop an original essay while giving credit for borrowed information and facts from outside sources. Students should not rely on long quotations but use their own words instead. Informal citations are acceptable where short quotations or paraphrases of longer passages are used.
- Each essay must be 450 600 words in length.
- It must be typed, double-spaced, size 12 true type font, e.g., Arial, Times New Roman, Calibri, and **converted to a pdf**, including the separate cover page that has also been **converted to a pdf**.
- Student's name can only appear on the cover sheet.
- Essay Title needs to be a **header** for the essay page(s).
- See page 4 of this document for the format of the cover page.
- No images will be accepted.
- Formal writing rules apply. See TN ELA standard W.TTP.1.
- The state rubrics will be rigorously applied. Winning essays will be checked for plagiarism.

### Please note:

- Each essay needs to be submitted in two parts:
  - The cover sheet formatted as outlined on page 4 of this document, and
  - The **essay**, with the title of the essay as the **ONLY** information appearing on the actual essay pages in a header with page numbers as needed.

# Not following these formatting guidelines and this protocol will result in the entrant being disgualified.

### Scoring:

### State Prizes:

### Deadlines and how to enter:

- The student will submit his/her essay, in two parts as described earlier, to one high school official (teacher, guidance counselor, instructional coach, etc.) who will then forward student entries to Dr. Powell before February 16, 2024.
- The student may also submit his/her essay and cover sheet directly to Dr. Powell by **February 16, 20234**.
- Dr. Powell, as contact person for the sponsoring DKG chapter (Beta Sigma), will forward the chapter contest winners to the state contest.

### **Confirmation:**

The chapter contact person (Dr. Powell) will confirm submission of entries as they are received.
